

Chapter 40

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Board of Commissioners 3-1-1978. Readopted as revised 1-8-1986 by Res. No. 85-6. Subsequent amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 40-1. Consumption.

It is hereby declared to be a nuisance and unlawful for any person to consume any intoxicating beverage in or on any of the public ways and streets of the Town of Thurmont, Maryland.

§ 40-2. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

INTOXICATING BEVERAGE -- Alcohol, brandy, whiskey, rum, gin, cordial, beer, ale, stout, wines, cider and other spirituous, vinous, malt or fermented liquor, liquor or compound, by whatever name called, containing 1/2 of 1% or more of alcohol by volume, which is fit for beverage purposes.

§ 40-3. Violations and penalties.

The violation of this chapter is declared to be a municipal infraction. The penalty for violation shall be the sum of \$50.
