July 22 – Every Day is Earth Day

We will have a presentation from Thurmont's Green Team and a Department of Natural Resources Naturalist will talk to us and assist us in planting at the Community Park. Learn how what we do on a daily basis affects the planet and how we can change the environment for the better. **Drop off and pick up at the Community Park.**

July 23 – Step Back in Time

We will spend the day at Catoctin Furnace learning what life was like back when the furnace was in full operation and participate in the activities of that time period. **Drop off and pick up at Catoctin Furnace.**

July 24 – The Keys to Baseball

Learn some basic baseball drills and skills and then top off the day with a walk to the Thurmont Regional Library for some surprises! **Drop off at the Community Park and pick up at the Thurmont Regional Library.**

July 25 – Sporting Around

August 1 – Trolley Travel
