**Article 1  
Definitions**

**§ 40-10. Definitions.**

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

1. **INTOXICATING BEVERAGE:** Alcohol, brandy, whiskey, rum, gin, cordial, beer, ale, porter, stout, wine, cider and other spirituous, vinous, malt or fermented liquor, liquid or compound, by whatever name called, containing 1/2 of 1% or more of alcohol by volume, which is fit for beverage purposes.
2. **PARKS:** Recreational area owned and/or maintained by the Town.
3. **TOWN:** Town of Thurmont, Maryland
4. **STREET:** Any public street, avenue, roadway, boulevard, highway, alley, cul-de-sac or other public place located in the Town and established for the use of vehicles.
5. **SIDEWALK:** A paved walk for foot passengers at the side of a street or road.

**Article 2  
Consumption**

**§ 40-20. Consumption.**

It is hereby declared to be a nuisance and unlawful for any person to consume any intoxicating beverage in or on any of the streets, sidewalks and parks of the Town.

**§ 40-21. Violations and penalties.**

The violation of this chapter is declared to be a municipal infraction. The penalty for violation shall be the sum of \$50.00.
